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SUBJECT: Public Hearing to consider the adoption of Fire Facility Fees to be collected by the City on behalf of the Scotts Valley Fire District

The City of Scotts Valley will hold a public hearing to consider the adoption of Fire Facility Fees to be collected by the City on behalf of the Scotts Valley Fire District in accordance with the Mitigation Fee Act (California Government Code §§66000-66025). The City Council will consider (1) an ordinance amending Section 15.20.030 of the Scotts Valley Municipal Code to add a Fire Facility Fee, (2) a resolution adopting the fees established by the Scotts Valley Fire District and (3) an agreement with the Scotts Valley Fire District regarding the establishment, imposition and collection of the impact fees.
