SUBJECT: DELINQUENT WASTEWATER SERVICE CHARGES

Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code §§5473–5473.3 and Scotts Valley Municipal Code §13.04.270, the City has prepared a report of delinquent wastewater service charges. At the time and place stated above, the City Council will hear and consider any objections or protests to the report.

Following the hearing, the City Council may adopt a resolution confirming the report, as submitted or revised. Upon confirmation, the delinquent charges will be placed on the Santa Cruz County secured property tax roll, where they will constitute liens against the respective properties and be collected in the same manner as property taxes.

A list of affected properties and the amount of each delinquent charge is on file and available for public review at the City of Scotts Valley Administrative Services Department, 1 Civic Center Drive, Scotts Valley, California.
